Located on the Great River Road between majestic bluffs and the Mississippi River, the historic City of Alma, Wisconsin, has hosted the Festival since its beginnings. The venue can also be reached by boat above Lock and Dam #4. Camping is available at nearby Rieck's Lake Park on a first come basis. The Festival is free and open to the public.
